We're looking for someone who is excited to join a dynamic, growing, small grassroots alliance and help develop the infrastructure and strategies to realize ambitious political goals. We seek a leader who is motivated to build and harness grassroots energy to be part of a larger movement through developing an individual membership structure, volunteer program, communications, electoral mobilizations, and other activities.

San Francisco Rising is an alliance of long-standing (10-45 years old) grassroots organizations organizing African-American, Latino, Chinese, and Filipino communities in San Francisco for housing & worker rights, environmental & racial justice, and youth & women's empowerment. We seek to build the political power of our communities to win lasting change on a broad set of issues.

We're looking for a strategic thinker, a team player, and highly competent program director. SFR is a collaborative and supportive work environment, committed to developing the leadership and skills of our staff and members.

- Develop and manage a base of volunteers

- Lead SFR electronic communications, including electronic newsletters, social media, and website postings
- Represent SFR with local and state ally organizations and coalitions

- Understanding of the ins and outs of local and/or state governance, and ability to communicate about the political landscape with grassroots members.

- Supervision experience. Ability to hire, train, and manage staff.

- Bilingual in English/Spanish highly desired
